SKATING LESSONS

Spring is a great time to get moving! Skating lessons from age 3 to adult, beginner to advanced. Each session consists of 7 one-hour classes which

Intro to Hockey: Begins Early November. Participants should skate independently and/or have completed at least one session of Skating Lessons. Ideal for ages 5-6

Mini-mites: Begins Early November. For beginners with some hockey skills. Ideal for ages 6-7

Rec Hockey for ages 9-13: Participants should skate independently, no hockey experience needed, but it is helpful. Begins in November.
