Example:

Social Studies Standard 1: History of the US and NY

Key Idea 1: The study of NYS and US history requires an analysis of the development of American culture, its diversity and multicultural context, and the ways people are unified by many values, practices, and traditions.

Performance Indicators: Elementary- Students understand the basic ideals of American democracy as explained in the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution and other documents.

Example:

ELA Standard 1: Students will read, write, listen, and speak for information and understanding.

Key Idea: Listening and reading to acquire information and understanding involves collection data, facts, and ideas; discovering relationships, concepts and generalizations; and using knowledge from oral, written and electronic sources.

Performance Indicators: Intermediate- Compare and synthesize information from different sources.
